PBA Annual General Meeting 2022

In October, the PBA held it's 70th Annual General Meeting at the Peace Experiment. It was great to see so many of our members in attendance; taking advantage of the opportunity to network with others, as well as engage in the important matters of the Association. We will also be holding a Special General Meeting so keep an eye out for the date.

Key takeaways from the evening included:

1.Updating members of the previous year's achievements such as the success of the Roller Door Art Project, Authentic Eats campaign and the great work PBA staff has done to deliver valuable services to our businesses.

2.Members approved a 3% Business Improvement District (BID) rate increase, adding \$13,716.29 for our 2023-2024 budget. These funds will go towards keeping up with the rising cost of supplies, maintaining our security and expanding our events capabilities.

3.Early 2023, we will be holding a Special General Meeting (SGM) for our members due to an update of the Business Improvement District Policy. Our Constitution will require updating to align with the policy.

4.Next year will mark a significant milestone for Panmure as it commemorates 175 years of the township. The PBA would love if you could share any stories/memories/photos of Panmure, it's people and local businesses (past & present).

A vital part of the PBA's work is attributed to the efforts of our Executive Committee Board members. While a position on the board is voluntary, the contributions of its members are very important to the ongoing governance, and strategic positioning of our township and its local businesses.

We're excited to usher in some new blood to the 2023 Executive Committee. These new members are Alex George, Deborah Misiuepa, Raj Rathood, and Sylvia Ruhl. Former board member, Norma McDonald will be also be returning. With all this new talent and experience on the board, there is sure to be some exciting meetings ahead.
