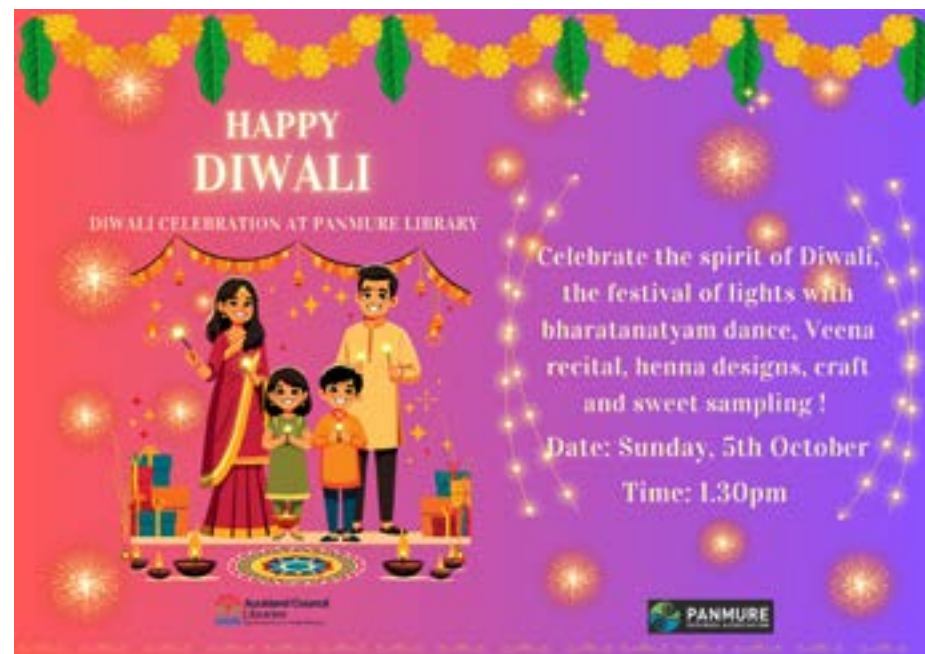

This project is an artist-led initiative, designed to beautify the area, add colour, and bring new energy to the heart of

Panmure. The very first mural on this wall was created by local artist Saskia (@saskia_eliane). Taking two weeks to complete and refine, her work sets the tone for what promises to become an exciting and ongoing series of murals.

The Good The Bad Studio hopes to refresh the wall regularly, ideally unveiling a new mural every two months. They are now calling on artists—emerging to established alike—to take part in future projects. By

creating a rotating platform for local talent, the initiative not only uplifts the community but also offers a space where art can connect people and stories.

As the murals are funded from the artists' own pockets, local businesses are warmly invited to support the project and show appreciation for the creativity transforming Panmure.
