I am happy to be back full-time in Panmure. I have been keeping an eye on things during lockdown and I have helped the police with their enquiries when required but on the whole things have been quiet in town. I have noticed over the last week we have had increased activity, tagging has been an issue and we have had a couple of vehicles broken into at night.

We photograph and report all tags for immediate removal and contractors are doing a great job of keeping on top of this. With regards to theft from vehicles, be aware there is a group operating in the area, do not give them any opportunity.

A recent development has local youth stealing cars in the community and using the vehicles to commit crime. Please report to the police and myself any suspicious activity.

We are aware of an incident where a local man approached a teen in the community hall car park. This girl did exactly the right thing and immediately called the police with a detailed description of the man. I was able to assist the police in identifying this individual and he has now been apprehended. There had been multiple incidents involving this male and we are delighted with the outcome.

he PBA is very proud to be a part of Whale Tales Art Trail 2022 where 80 tail sculptures can be viewed across the Auckland region as part of an interactive trail.

From 27 January - 18 April 2022 a trail of unique and stunning whale tail sculptures, designed by artists and children, will animate Tāmaki Makaurau and bring to life themes of protecting and restoring the mauri of our Ocean. The 80 sculptures will be located in Auckland's streets, parks, and open spaces to provide residents and visitors a fresh opportunity to explore the City of Sails.

We will be hosting our very own sculpture here in Panmure, outside 104 Queens Road – for all the community to view and enjoy. The Whale Tale Art Trail will bring many people who have downloaded the Trail App, to Panmure, as they complete the trail across Auckland. the Māori Star Compass was chosen by
the members of the Panmure Business
Association in recognition of the

e wish to extend a warm welcome to Stream Community Church who have recently moved upstairs at 100 Queens Road.


